Djerassi Resident Artists Program announces their new Interim Executive Director, Marcelle Hinand. Marcy comes to Djerassi with over 25 years of experience working with nonprofit organizations and foundations on strategy, program development and management. She has consulted for top tier arts funders such as the Rainin Foundation, Annenberg Foundation, and others and was Program Director for the Arts at the James Irvine Foundation. Marcy served as Project Manager and co-author of the National Endowment for the Arts 2017 publication Creativity Connects: Trends and Conditions Affecting U.S. Artists, with the Center for Cultural Innovation. She recently led an effort with Yerba Buena Center for the Arts in San Francisco to pilot new structures and supports for artists and arts workers in the Bay Area related to advocacy and employment. Marcy holds a B.A. from Skidmore College and an M.F.A. from Brown University. She lives in San Francisco with her husband, the poet August Kleinzahler, and has two college-age sons.
